Tolton is someone we should all learn about and whom we should pray to and pray for. God willing, in the not too distant future, we'll be praying in thanksgiving for "Saint" Augustus Tolton. Dear Friends in Christ,

“Come, follow me... and heal our world.”

We have been listening to the call of Jesus to follow him these past three years. Each time we come to understand more fully what

following him means. Today’s Gospel helps us to see that following him means healing our troubled and fragile world.

Notice how Jesus brings healing precisely where we need it in our lives and relationships. When confronted by anger, he offers peace and right relationships. When tempted to be unfaithful in our commitments, he offers the grace of faithful and life-giving love. And, when we become trapped in self-deception and lies, he liberates us with the truth of his unconditional love and mercy.

His healing gifts of peace, love, mercy and truth are needed now more than ever in our Church, our nation, our world, and in our families. We all need Christ’s healing, and when we accept it, he empowers us to be his healing presence in our world. Healing others has always been the proof of the discipleship we share as a community.

Through the Annual Catholic Appeal, we together join Christ in his great work, by helping parishes and schools in need, supporting programs of faith formation, and those that promote justice, peace, and respect for life. THIS COMING SATURDAY, FEBRUARY 22



Father Augustus Tolton was the first identified black American ordained to the priesthood in the United States. He was born into slavery and escaped to freedom with his mother and siblings under harrowing circumstances.

Cardinal Francis George opened Tolton's cause for canonization in 2010. Pope Francis declared him "venerable" on June 11, 2019.

In "**Augustus Tolton: The Church is the True Liberator**," Joyce Duriga brings to light Father Tolton's quiet witness as a challenge to prejudices and narrow-mindedness that can keep us insulated from the universal diversity of the kingdom of God.

THE UNION OF TERROR AND BEAUTY 3

What do people usually do when driving on a long-distance trip - listen to a book, give someone a call, or play their favorite songs? Lately, I was introduced to a Dutch band named Haevn. This band is pretty good. It is clever to combine a crisp voice with an orchestra. It might be good to dim the light, light a candle and enjoy the songs (of course, not in the car!). Let's look at some examples of their songs.

Bright Lights: "Your words are high and running through a tired mind; a howling wind surrounds you; I'm trying to illuminate a clouded heart." (Haevn. Lyrics from "Bright Lights." Genius, on 2/10/2020, <https://genius.com/Haevn-bright-lights-lyrics>) The author has a strong desire to have a bright light giving him guidance. I would love to borrow these beautiful lyrics to talk about God: the Word of God (Scripture), filled with the Holy Spirit, gives rest for the truth-yearning mind; it magnifies the capacity to love for a restless heart; and it shows him/her the way by its radiant light.

Where The Heart Is: The refrain of this song is rather interesting. It says, "Where the heart is; when the light's at your side; when faith is ready; no more guidance; take the leap of your life." (Haevn. Lyrics from "Where the Heart Is." Genius, on 2/10/2020, <https://genius.com/Haevn-where-the-heart-is-lyrics>) It reminded me of Matthew 6:21 when Jesus

says, "For where your treasure is, there will your heart also be." It is true that when our hearts are in union with God's, we no longer need any guidance because we entrust ourselves to the Lord. Every leap that we take to shake off the trouble in our souls will be God's will. Hope we will get there soon.

That's how I internally translate the songs when I listen to music. On Wednesday, February 19, our parish is going to have a praise and worship night. It starts at 7:00pm. Maybe you might experience the union of terror and beauty in music that night.

NEW ENERGIES IN THE ST. JULIE FAMILY






