## FROM OUR PASTOR

For the past few weeks, you may have noticed we have not been printing the text of the Sunday Mass readings. We have also moved back to a separate worship aid for Mass, also not containing the text of the Sunday readings.

In terms of the readings, it was recently discovered that there is a

copyright on the text of the Sunday readings. This was news to me! I took for granted that the words of Scripture were open for everyone. Although Scripture itself is for everyone, the copyright applies to the way the text is printed. In other words, in order to reprint the Sunday readings in any parish media the spacing, indentations, and the physical look of the reprinting must match the original source. So, in order for us to reprint the text of the Sunday readings, we would first need to purchase a license AND we would have to reprint them exactly the way the text appears on the copyrighted source. This, unfortunately would take up an enormous amount of space.

Many parishes utilize Missalettes. However, they also require subscriptions that sometimes can come at a hefty price even for the minimum number of copies that need to be part of any subscription even if there is any discount in price. Given our financial situation, I felt this would be burdensome, so it didn't seem like the right choice.

When I arrived here a year ago, I understood that the parish had always provided a worship aid. The worship aids contained the lyrics and music of the hymns that would be sung at Masses, but they never included the text of the Sunday readings. Instead, the idea had been to encourage a fuller and active participation. This was to foster an active and engaged listening to the proclamation of God's Word. Rather than have peoples' eyes focused on a piece of paper, the value was to have people look up and focus attention to the pulpit where the Word of God was being proclaimed in "real time."

Still, I know that some people are "visual people" and pay attention better if they are able to follow along with the text of the readings. In the absence of a

parish resource, there are a few options that parishioners might choose.

One option would be to go to a website like [www.usccb.org](http://www.usccb.org). From there, you can find the daily readings for Mass. Prior to the weekend Mass, you might choose to pray with the readings, becoming familiar with the text. Then, when it is proclaimed at Mass, you will still be able to follow along because you were able to spend time earlier with the readings.

If you still need to have the text in front of you, there is always the option of printing a copy of the readings from the **USCCB website** and bring it with you to Mass. There is no infringement of copyright if you as a parishioner were to do this for yourself. It is only when the parish provides copies of the readings for the general congregation where infringement becomes an issue.

Another way would be to use a smartphone if you have one. We may not think of our smartphones as ways to grow in our faith but in this day and age they truly have become more than a tool to make phone calls. So, for those who have the ability to download apps, there is an app for virtually everything. If you can access the internet through your smartphone, you can go to the **USCCB website** during Mass and follow along with the readings.

There are many other apps that provide the texts of the Sunday readings along with other devotional resources. Among those apps, there is **Truth & Life**. This is an app that was developed by a Catholic group and is meant for use by Catholics. The app contains a link to the readings assigned for every day. It even has the entire Bible in one single place that you can access all on a smartphone. It also has links to **Word On Fire** (made popular by Bishop Robert Barron) as well EWTN Live. There is even a link that connects you to an audio recitation of the Rosary. I use this and it has been a very handy app.

For those who are more familiar with the Divine Office (aka Liturgy of the Hours), there is even an app called **iBreviary**. This app contains all the texts and prayers of the Liturgy of the Hours, the entire Mass for each day, and even the daily readings. This is another app that I have on my own smartphone and has come in handy especially when I am traveling. It gives me the convenience of having all the prayers I

need to celebrate Mass without having to bring with me all sorts of books. I have used this app on vacations and trips to celebrate a private Mass in the event that I cannot get permission to celebrate a Mass at one of the local parishes.

For those who may not be tech savvy, there are also printed resources available. However, these would require a subscription. One popular resource widely used is the **Magnificat**. Subscription information may be found at [us.magnificat.net](http://us.magnificat.net). The Magnificat is a personal booklet that people can use to pray the daily Mass readings and other prayers. I, personally, do not have a subscription, but I know parishioners who do use it and those I spoke with truly love it. The Magnificat magazine has been a tool that has helped Catholics become more engaged in their faith and provides a way to follow along with the Mass no matter their location. If you do not have access to a computer, call the Parish Office. The Front Desk has subscription information.

Whatever option you may choose, I thank you for understanding the need to go this route.



# POPE ESTABLISHES WORLD DAY

## POPE ESTABLISHES WORLD DAY FOR GRANDPARENTS AND THE ELDERLY July 25, 2021

Pope Francis has decided to institute a Church-wide celebration of a World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly. Starting this year, it will be held on the fourth Sunday of July, close to the liturgical memorial of Saints Joachim and Anne, the grandparents of Jesus.

Recalling the upcoming feast of the Presentation of Jesus in the Temple – when the elderly Simeon and Anna encountered the child Jesus and recognized Him as the Messiah – Pope Francis said, “the Holy Spirit even today stirs up thoughts and words of wisdom in the elderly.” The voice of the elderly “is precious,” he said, “because it sings the praises of God and preserves the roots of the peoples.”

The elderly, he continued, “remind us that old age is a gift and that grandparents are the link between the different generation, to pass on to the young the experience of life.”

Further encouraging the elderly to “set out and undertake something new” in spite of the doubts and questions they might have, he reminded them that Jesus himself heard a similar question when Nicodemus asked him “how can a man be born when he is old” (John 3:4).

It can happen, “if we open our hearts to the working of the Holy Spirit, who blows where he wills. The Holy Spirit whose freedom is such that goes wherever, and does whatever he wills,” the Pope said.

Finally, Pope Francis spoke on prayer, recalling Pope Benedict XVI’s words: “the prayer of the elderly can protect the world, helping it perhaps more effectively than the frenetic activity of many others.

## FAMILY FAITH SHARING

In today's Gospel (Mark 6:30-34), Jesus encourages His apostles to come away from the crowds and rest, but the crowds will not give them peace. The crowds continue to approach them and Mark reports that the disciples don't even have time to eat. In an effort to get away, Jesus invites them to board a boat in the hope of finding a deserted place. But the crowds notice this and arrive ahead of them. The Gospel tells us that Jesus is moved with pity and begins to teach the crowds. But, in addition, He affirms the importance of rest and renewal.

Family demands can sometimes make us feel like Jesus and the twelve. We wish for times of relaxation and renewal but there are errands to run, household tasks to maintain and volunteer commitments to keep. These are all good things, but we can be left feel tired and drained as we try to keep up. One of the gifts we can give to one another in our family life is assistance in finding time and space to renew ourselves through prayer so that we may be better disciples of Jesus.

**Minimize plastic waste.** Humans buy 1,000,000 plastic bottles every minute! 
