## FROM OUR PASTOR

This weekend, I wanted to share with everyone three things that are currently in the works. The first is a project presented to me by one of our teen parishioners who is working on attaining the high rank of Eagle Scout. He is planning and implementing a project that could benefit a

particular community. He has chosen to do something for our parish since he and his family have made St. Julie's their spiritual home. Since he is still under 18 years old, I do not at this time want to share his name publicly.

So what is this Scout proposing to do? He would like to create a memorial area on our campus to honor living and deceased veterans. Right now, he is still working on getting the project approved by the Scout leadership.

The hope is that the Veterans Memorial will include a United States flag mounted on a pole. At the base of the flagpole, our Scout would like to create a brick "meditation space" where each brick could be engraved with names of living or deceased veterans. The Scout and I are thinking of the grassy area on the south side of the church just east of the sidewalk that leads to the church doors.



Initially, this might sound like a very ambitious undertaking both in cost and in scope. Our Scout hopes to complete the project in about a year but has until he turns 18 years old to complete it. At this point, there are no details since he is still working on getting the project approved. Once the approval process has been completed, we will be able to sit down and work out the details. For now, we can all be assured that this is in the works.

The second thing that I would like to share is that I met with four parishioners who are willing to serve as the core group to resume our monthly bingo. They are Tom and Mercedes Nolan, Fran Jurek and Marni Cothorn. As I met with them several weeks ago to

discuss the plan to resume bingo, it became evident that a core group would be needed to take a leadership role in moving forward. I am happy that they have graciously volunteered their time.


However, what also became clearly evident is that the core group will need a cadre of volunteers before bingo can be resumed. The core group members are willing to take the role of leaders but cannot move ahead until a good number of parishioners come forward to volunteer in several areas.

We do not have a target date set to resume bingo. The first step was to appeal to parishioners to come forward and sign up as

volunteers. Bingo is a fun time that brings people together as well as being a strong source of extra income for the parish. Those parishioners who are interested may contact me or speak directly with one of the core group members.

The final event I would like to share is a Pilgrimage to the Holy Land for November 2022. This Pilgrimage is primarily open to parishioners of St. Julie Billiart, but of course, we would welcome friends of the parish. The group would probably be a maximum of 30-40 pilgrims which makes it easier to manage while overseas. If all goes well, we are looking at a departure date of November 8, 2022 where we will make a pilgrimage to the Holy Land. This is also in the initial planning stages. I am currently working with the tour company that I have used previously for several pilgrimages. We are finalizing the dates, itinerary, and cost. Once the details have been worked out and a flyer put together, registration information will be available for all interested parties!

We plan to visit the usual sites of the life and ministry of Jesus. We will also visit the region of Galilee and Nazareth. The trip will continue on to the town of Nazareth and Cana. We will also be able to have time to swim in the Dead Sea and renew our baptismal promises in the Jordan River. The culmination of the pilgrimage will be the time spent in the Holy City of Jerusalem as well as Bethlehem.



I will keep parishioners posted of this event as the details develop. For now, those interested may start saving the dates as well as “save up” for the trip.




As with other pilgrimages to the Holy Land, there will inevitably be concerns about safety. To this, I will say that tourism is big business for everyone in that part of the world. Despite the ongoing conflicts, visiting the Holy Land has been safe and the tourist companies do a great job in keeping pilgrims out of harm’s way. In terms of health safety with the ongoing struggles with COVID, at the start of summer 2021, the Holy Land reopened has been receiving pilgrims. Health protocols are in place and whatever those might be by next year will be followed. As with every pilgrimage, though, travelers are strongly encouraged to take out travel insurance in the event that emergencies do arise.

Like I have said on other occasions, good things are happening at our parish. I hope we all look forward to many more good things to come.

## CELEBRATE THE SEASON OF CREATION

The Season of Creation is a month-long prayerful observance that calls upon Catholics to pray and care for God's Creation (**September 1 - October 4**). It's a time to reflect on our relationship with the environment, how we live, and how our lifestyles impact the natural world, humans and other creature inhabiting it. We are part of nature, included in it and thus in constant interaction with it." (LS 139). Advocating for Creation Care helps safeguard the inheritance the Creator has given us, ... an inheritance essential to our well-being. Pope Benedict XVI told us that protecting this inheritance is a way of fulfilling our role as stewards of Creation.

At this meeting, we will focus on the current job market and the specific job search needs of the attendees.




