## OUR LADY OF FATIMA

Later this week, on May 13 to be precise, it will be the feast day of Our Lady of Fatima. The story of Fatima is one that many of us Catholics know and love. The image of Our Lady of Fatima remains a very popular image of the Virgin Mary used in many people's homes and churches.

Perhaps part of the reason for the popularity is that the apparitions at Fatima, Portugal took place just about 105 years ago. Of course, anyone who was an eyewitness has passed away. Even Sister Lucia who was one of the three children to whom the Virgin Mary appeared died back in 2005. Still, the memory of the events of Fatima are still etched in the minds of many Catholics.

On May 13, 1917, the Virgin Mary appeared to three children in the small town of Fatima almost in central Portugal. One of the three children and the main person attached to the apparitions was Sister Lucia whose birth name was Lucia Dos Santos. After the apparitions, Lucia entered the Carmelite Order of sisters and became known as Sister Lucia. The other two children were her cousins Francisco and Jacinta.

In the accounts of the apparitions, the children revealed that the Virgin Mary appeared to them dressed in a white mantle edged in gold. She was standing on a cloud in an evergreen tree and held a rosary in her hands. The appearance of the Virgin Mary at Fatima was, of course, timely because she proclaimed a message that World War I could come to an end if people prayed and turned away from sin. The war did end about a year later.

As is the case with all other Marian apparitions, there was much resistance in believing that the claims of three illiterate children were true. The idea was just too farfetched. There were a total of six apparitions beginning in May of 1917 and ending on October 13 of the same year. There was an apparition once a month during that time period. At the second apparition, the Virgin Mary informed the three children that Jacinta and Francisco were going to heaven soon but that Lucia would live longer. As the months passed by, more and more people were

joining the children hoping to get a glimpse of the Virgin Mary. However, the Virgin Mary was only visible to the three children. Obviously, there was much hesitation and reluctance in believing the account of the three children. It was during the last apparition that the Virgin Mary finally revealed her identity referring to herself as Our Lady of the Rosary.

In regards to the story of Our Lady of Fatima, familiar to many of us would be the Miracle of the Sun. This took place during the last apparition on October 13, 1917. The crowd that day was estimated at being anywhere from 30,000 to 100,000 individuals. Witnesses say that the sun danced around in the sky. The day had started with heavy rain. When the rain stopped, the sun appeared. But, then the sun moved around in the sky in unexplainable patterns. At one point, it was said that the sun even approached the earth to a distance that should have been dangerous and destructive. However, after the miracle, the ground and the peoples' wet clothing were completely dry. There were even some people present who claimed that they did not see anything happen to the sun. Scientists from that time period also reported that there was no unusual phenomenon of the sun observed that day. This has caused skepticism in both the scientific and religious worlds. But, no one can deny that a good number of people experienced something that day.



Another well known aspect of the Fatima story would be the three secrets entrusted to Sister Lucia. The first secret was a vision of hell seen by Lucia herself on July 4, 1917. The second secret was an instruction for devotion to the Immaculate Heart of Mary as a way to bring an end to World War I. However, the second secret came with a caveat that if people still did not repent of the sins that offend God, another disastrous and global war would come. The prediction came true when World War II erupted. The third and final secret entrusted to Sister Lucia was not revealed until much later. In fact, Sister Lucia was instructed by the Virgin Mary that she was not make it known until after 1960. When it was finally revealed, the secret predicted the violent deaths of the Holy Father and other religious leaders.

The consecration of Russia was also a big part of the apparitions at Fatima. As we know from history, the influence of Communism was very strong during that time and it was having a global effect. The Virgin Mary called for a consecration of Russia to her Immaculate Heart in order to reign in an era of peace. As we also know from recent history, this act of consecration was made again as a result of the conflict between Russia and the Ukraine. This time, both countries were consecrated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary as the Holy Father prayed before the statue of Our Lady of Fatima in her shrine in Portugal. The act of consecration is a special prayer that the mercy of God that we receive through the intercession of Mary be a powerful force that changes the hearts of every human being.

As we come to the 105th anniversary of the apparition of the Virgin Mary to Sister Lucia and her two cousins, it becomes important once again for all believers to consecrate ourselves to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. We pray that, through her intercession and prayers, the mercy of God might be more powerfully felt in our own lives. In that way, we become even more effective instruments of God's mercy in the world today. May the Virgin Mary Our Lady of Fatima continue to pray for the world that God's peace may fully reign in the hearts of all men and women.

## FAMILY FAITH SHARING

The fourth Sunday of Easter is often called Good Shepherd Sunday. In the Gospel for today, Jesus, the Good Shepherd describes His care for His sheep. The image of Jesus as Good Shepherd and the community of followers as His sheep has endured over time as a primary image in our faith tradition. This shepherd/sheep image speaks to us about the

protection, security and care that shepherds represent for their sheep. Today's Gospel (John 10:27-30) speaks powerfully about the familiarity and intimacy between Jesus and His Father. Jesus and His Father. Jesus identifies so closely with the Father that He tells us they are one...not just close, but one. Our relationship with Jesus is an invitation to share in the life of God. Often, not only can we identify the voices of our family members, but we can also easily read the tone of their voices and know something about how they are feeling.

### Laundry Energy Saving Tips



There are two ways to reduce the amount of energy used for washing clothes – use less water and use cooler water. Unless you're dealing with oily stains, the warm or cold water setting on your machine will generally do a good job of cleaning your clothes. Switching your temperature setting from hot to warm can cut a load's energy use in half.

- Wash your clothes in cold water using cold-water detergents whenever possible.
- Wash and dry full loads. If you are washing a small load, use the appropriate water-level setting.
- Dry towels and heavier cottons in a separate load from lighter-weight clothes.
- Don't over-dry your clothes. If your machine has a moisture sensor, use it.
- Clean the lint screen in the dryer after every load to improve air circulation and prevent fire hazards.




